Summary of Activities – 2018

Introduction

This memorandum summarizes the activities for the West Valley Citizen Task Force in 2018. This summary is intended to be an aid to discussion and decision-making for 2019.

Meetings, Presentations and Other Accomplishments

During 2018 the CTF accomplished the following:

- Six CTF meetings were held. The CTF continued to forgo four meetings in favor of the Quarterly Public Meetings scheduled on the days the CTF meeting would traditionally have been held. - Topics of presentations and discussions at CTF meetings included:
 - CHBWV Project updates. (Multiple updates and presentations based on the four contract milestones: High-Level Waste Move; Legacy Waste Operations; Facility Disposition – MPPB and Vitrification Facility; Balance of Site Facilities; and safety)
 - Particular attention was paid to the Vitrification Facility Demolition.
 - Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement process and schedule and CTF discussion concerning comments on the scoping
 - NYSERDA updates on SDA Geomembrane Cover Replacement and SDA Leachate Elevations
 - Overview of the Town of Ashford Proposal for a Solar Facility on the Retained Premises
 - Permeable Treatment Wall Update
 - Annual Site Environmental Report for 2017
- An ad hoc working group was formed to develop comments on the SEIS Scoping
- An ad hoc Technical Work Group was formed to develop comments on the DOE proposal to reinterpret “high-level radioactive waste” (HLW), as proposed in 83 FR 50909-11
- Members visited the site viewing the creeks, erosion control measures, dam area, SDA and NDA and the area surrounding the Main Plant Process Building
- Website maintenance and updates continued throughout the year
