## Public meeting scheduled on main plant process building demolition at WVDP

The Ashford Town Board, at its Aug. 11 meeting, heard from Communications and External Affairs Manager Joseph Pillittere regarding a public meeting on the demolition of the main plant process building at the **West Valley Demonstration Project**.

The meeting will be Wednesday, Aug. 25 and will be held in two sessions from 5:30-6:30 p.m. and 7-8 p.m. at the West Valley Volunteer Hose Company Firemen's Memorial Hall, located at 9085 Route 240 in **West Valley**. Due to COVID-19 restrictions, people looking to attend must reserve a spot by contacting Pillittere at [Joseph.Pillittere@chbwv.com](mailto:Joseph.Pillittere@chbwv.com) or 942-4996.

The meeting, hosted by the U.S. Department of Energy, will provide information on the safe demolition of the main plant process building and will include presentations, informational stations and subject matter experts to answer questions.

Due to new guidelines from the federal government, all in-person meetings will be limited to 50 attendees and will require attestation of having been vaccinated or a negative COVID-19 test three days prior to the meeting. Attendees will be required to wear a mask and comply with physical distancing requirements.

In other board news:

– Supervisor John Pfeffer reported this year's bike rodeo was well attended and was well conducted. Four bikes were donated by Pillittere for participants to have a chance to win, with selected winners being very appreciative.

– Pfeffer reported the town has submitted for a COPS grant, which has not been awarded yet. Grants are also currently being researched for a truck stop/ welcome area within the town.

– Highway Superintendent Keith Butcher reported CHIPS work has been completed in the town. Crews are also currently cutting back trees around sidewalks for safer walking.
