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DOE Awards New Contract for Probabilistic Performance Assessment (PPA) Modeling

The contractor will support the DOE mission at **WVDP** and **WNYNSC** by performing the following services including, but not limited to the following: development of the probabilistic performance assessment (PPA) modeling and statistical decision analysis of proposed decommissioning alternatives to support Phase 2 decommissioning decision making.
